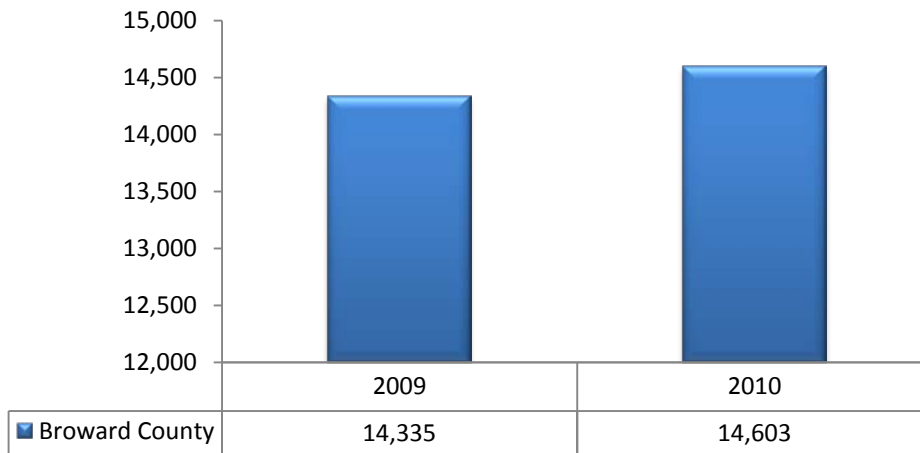


District 9, MORTALITY

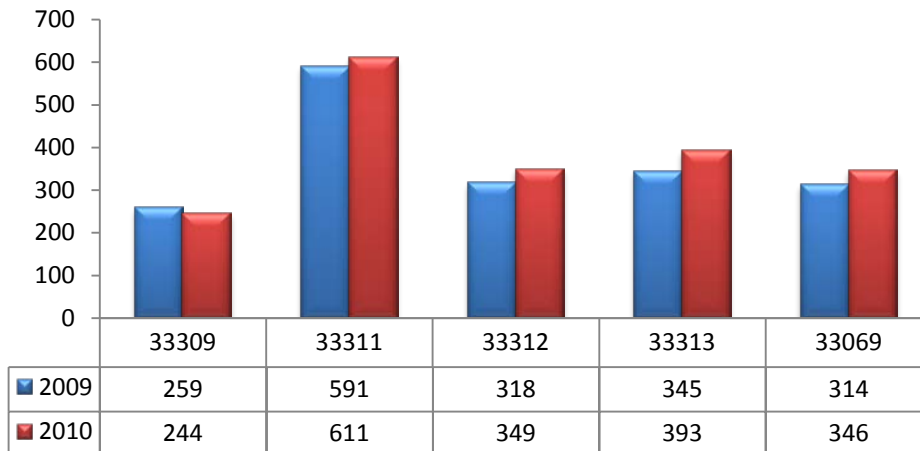
The following graphs illustrate the total number of deaths from all causes in Broward County, Broward County Commission District 9, and zip code 33069 for 2009 and 2010. The total number of deaths in 2010 for zip code 33309 had a slight decrease, when compared to 2009. The remaining zip codes, as well as Broward County, saw an increase in their total number of deaths from 2009 to 2010.

MAJOR CAUSES OF DEATH

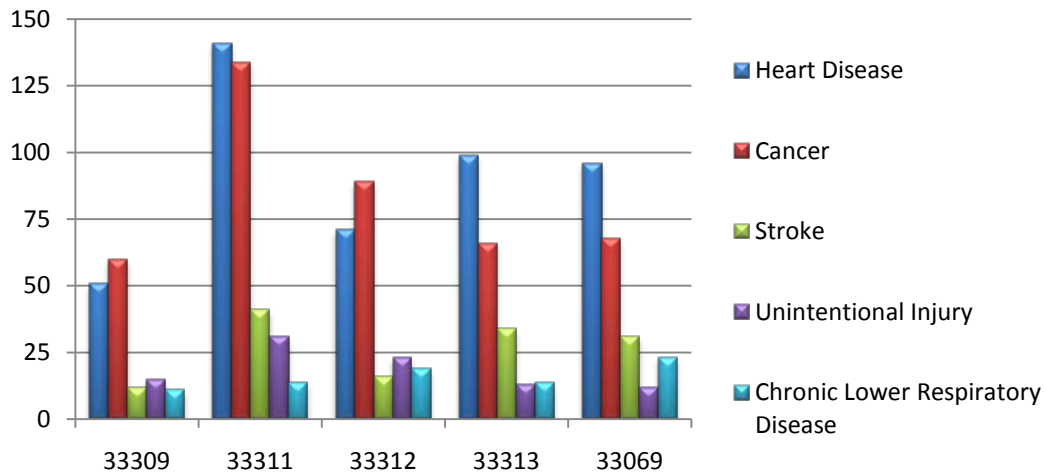
The following table and graph outline the major causes of the death by age, race/ethnicity and gender. The top three leading causes of death for 2010 in Broward County, District 9, and zip code 33069 are heart disease, cancer, and stroke. In Broward County Commission District 9, the total number of deaths is approximately 11% of the Broward County total.

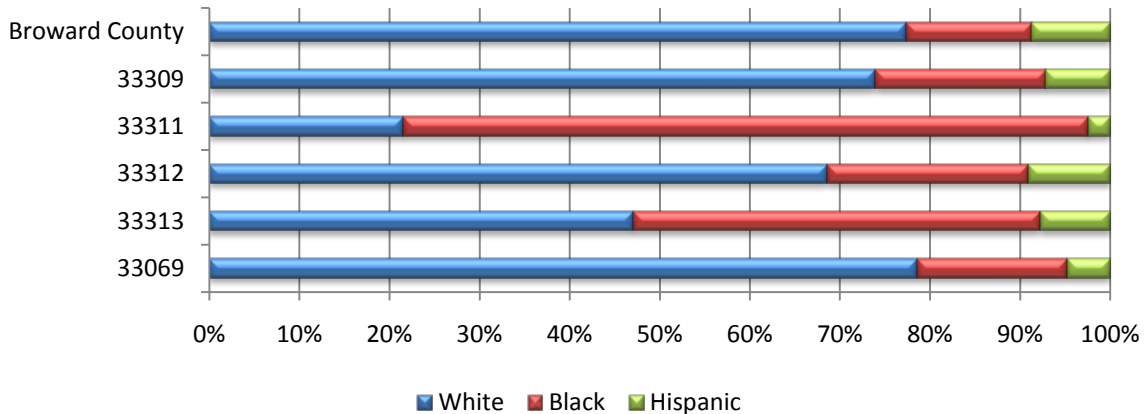
Major Causes of Death, 2010

The graph below illustrates the major causes of death by race and ethnicity. In District 9, the white population had the highest death counts in zip codes 33309, 33312, and 33313; while zip code 33311 showed the black population having the largest death count, at approximately 75% of the total. In Broward County, as well as in zip code 33069, the white population had the greatest number of deaths at nearly 80% of the total.

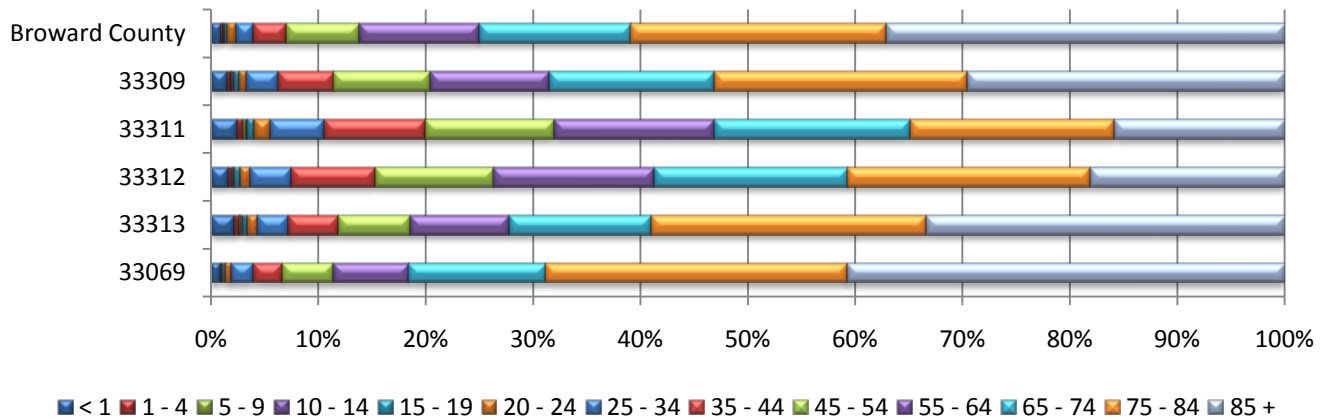
Major Causes of Death by Race/Ethnicity, 2010

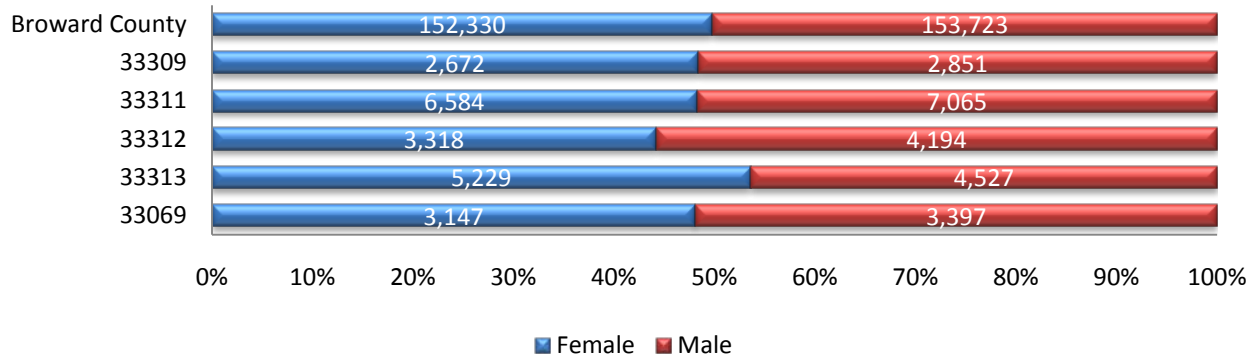
The 85 years and over age group leads in the highest number of deaths for Broward County and District 9. The leading deaths in this age group are due to heart disease, stroke, and chronic lower respiratory disease. However, in zip codes 33311 and 33312, there are a larger number of deaths (nearly 50%) within the age range of 55 – 84, when compared to the 85 years and over age group (nearly 15%).

Major Causes of Death by Gender, 2010

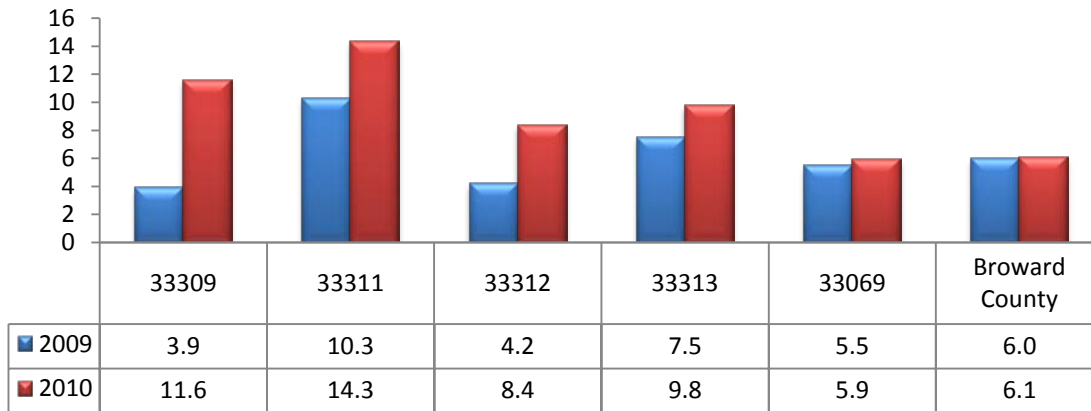

INFANT MORTALITY

The following figure illustrates the rate of infants (per 1,000 births) who died before their first birthday. In Broward, the infant mortality rate has remained constant from 2009 to 2010; while in District 9 and zip code 33069, there is an increase in the rate from 2009 to 2010. The infant mortality rate in zip code 33309, increased by nearly three times the amount from 2009 to 2010; and zip code 33311 has had a consistently higher infant mortality rate, with the 2010 rate being approximately 2.5 times larger than the Broward County rate.

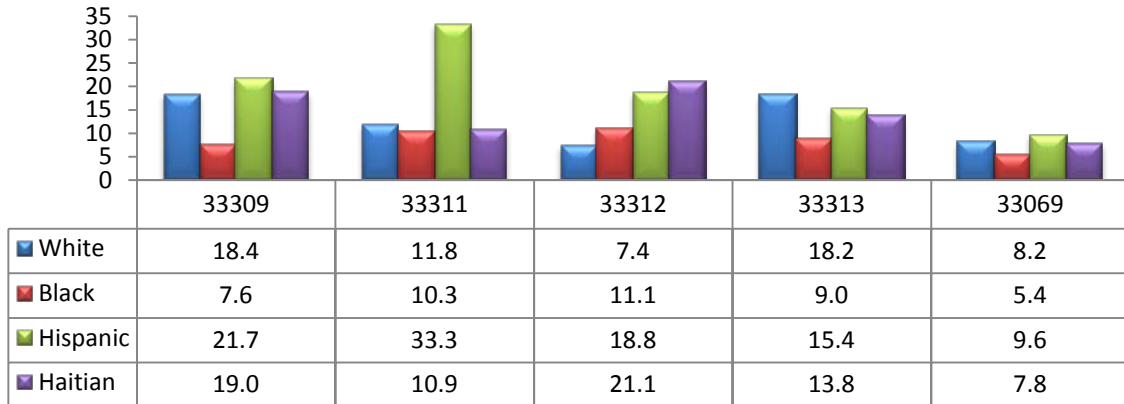
Infant Mortality Rate, 2009 & 2010

In zip code 33311, the infant mortality rate by race/ethnicity is relatively the same for the White, Black, and Haitian populations, but the Hispanic population has a rate that is about three times larger than the other populations. Within the other zip codes, the Hispanic population has either the highest or second highest rate, when it comes to infant mortality. The lowest infant mortality rate for all zip codes is seen within the Black population, excluding zip code 33312.

Infant Mortality Rate by Race/Ethnicity, 2010

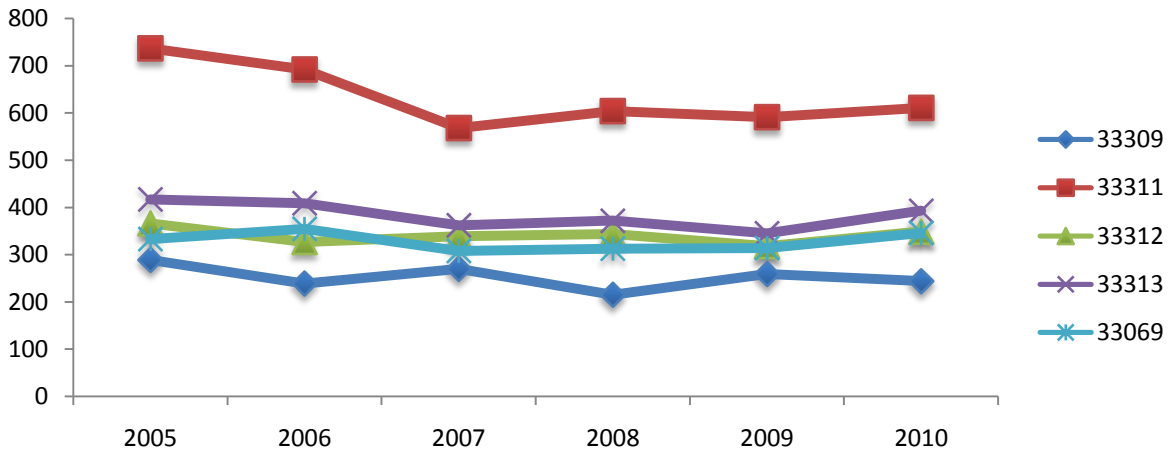

SUICIDE DEATH COUNTS

Suicides indicate that people are having difficulty coping with personal crisis, serious health problems, or other life stresses. Within Broward County Commission District 9, zip code 33309 has the lowest number of suicide related deaths in 2010, while zip code 33311 has had the highest number of suicide deaths since 2005.

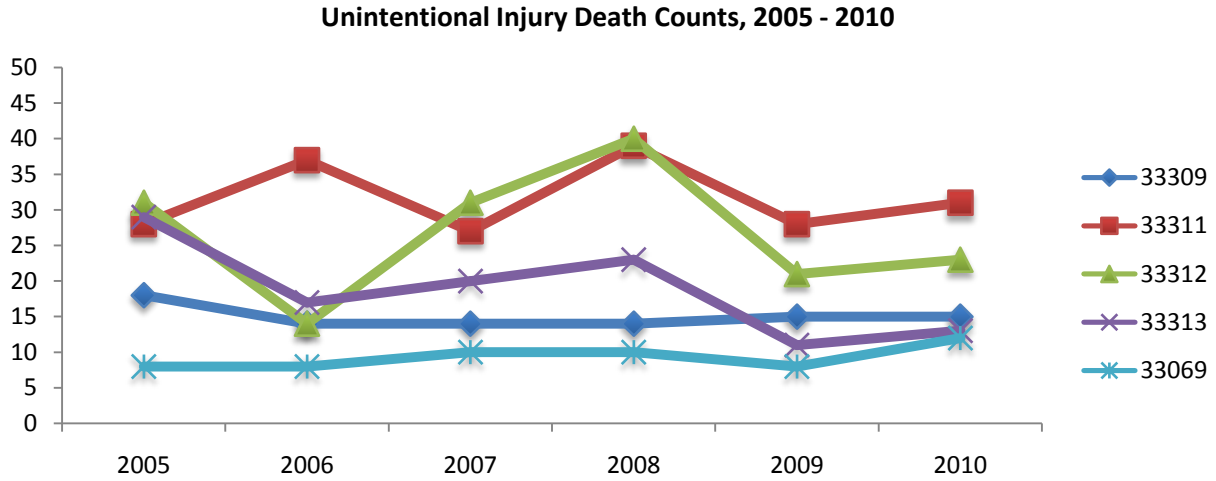
Suicide Death Counts, 2005 - 2010

UNINTENTIONAL DEATH COUNTS

Unintentional death counts include deaths by drowning, falls, fires, poisonings, medical and surgical care complications, all motor vehicle traffic crashes, and alcohol-related motor vehicle traffic crashes. Zip code 33069 has had the lowest number of unintentional injury related deaths since 2005.

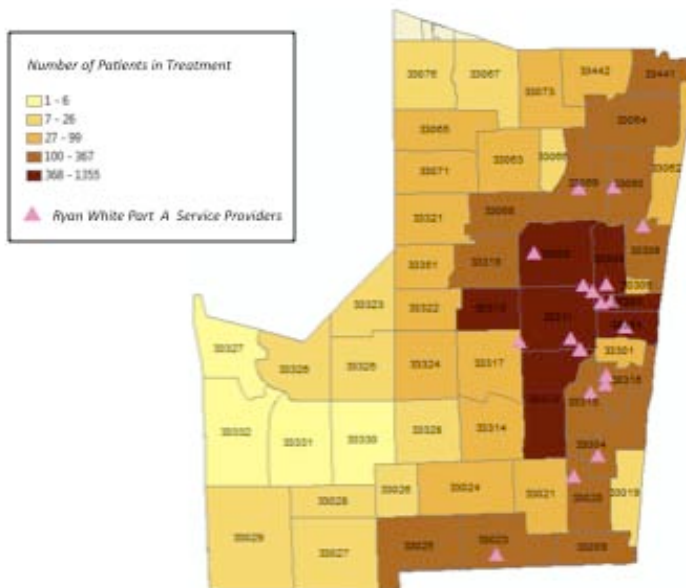
