

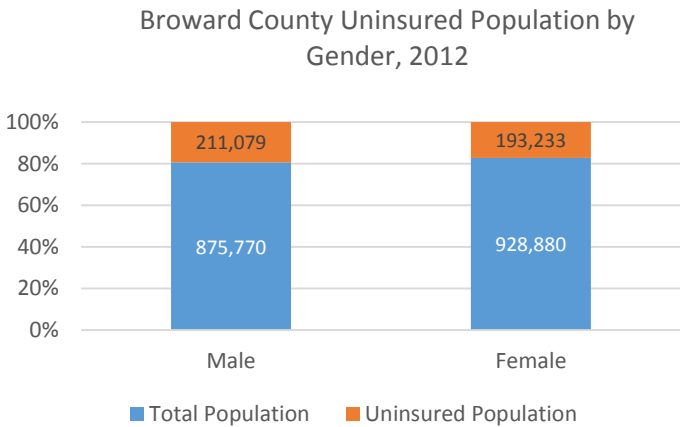
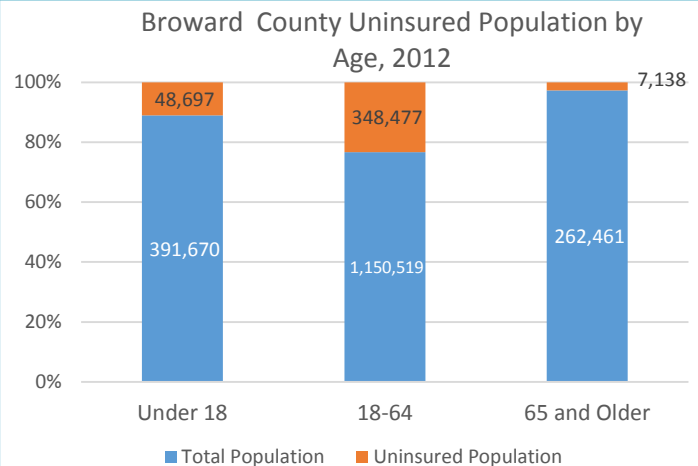
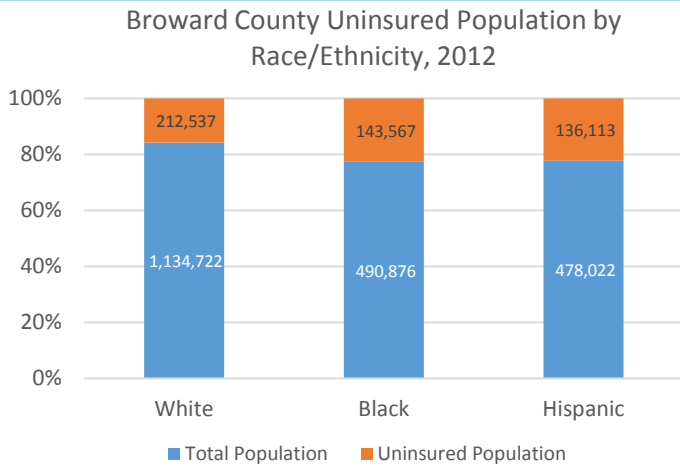

Broward Health Insurance Quick Facts



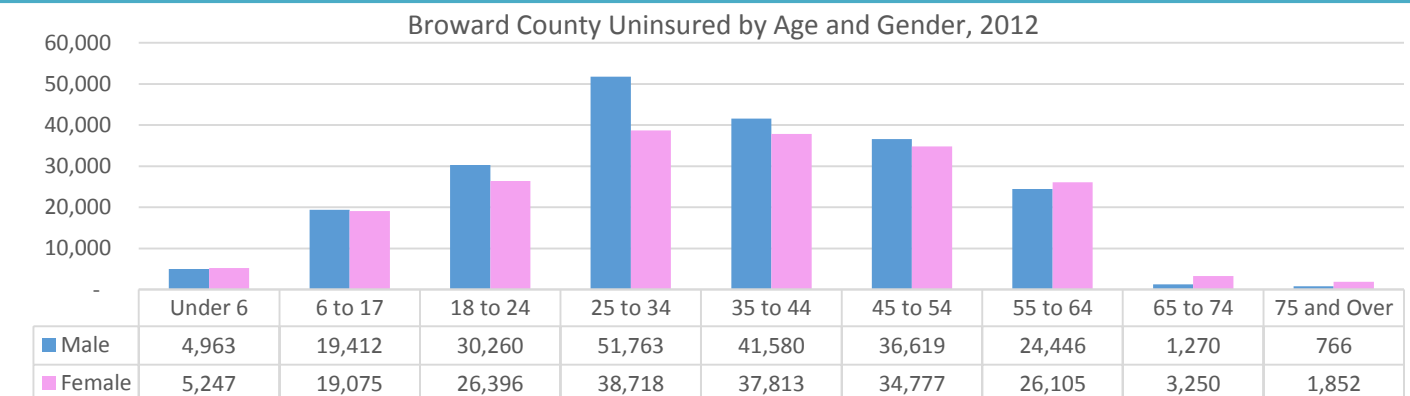
The overall uninsured rate for Broward decreased from 22.9 percent in 2011 to 22.4 percent in 2012; however, the Broward uninsured rates remain higher than Florida rates, indicating Broward residents are disproportionately impacted by the lack of affordable health insurance.

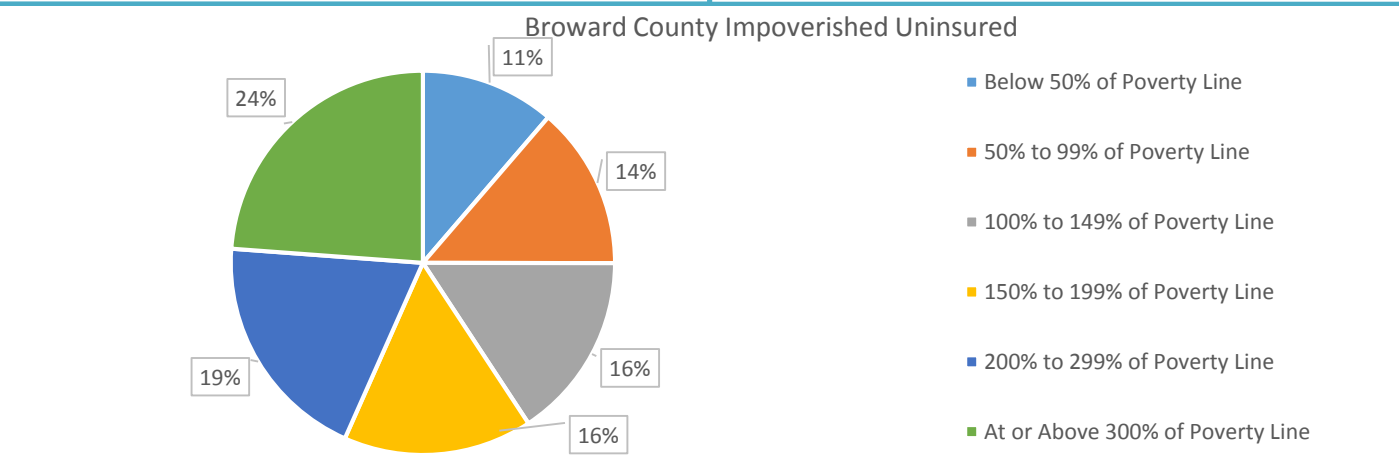
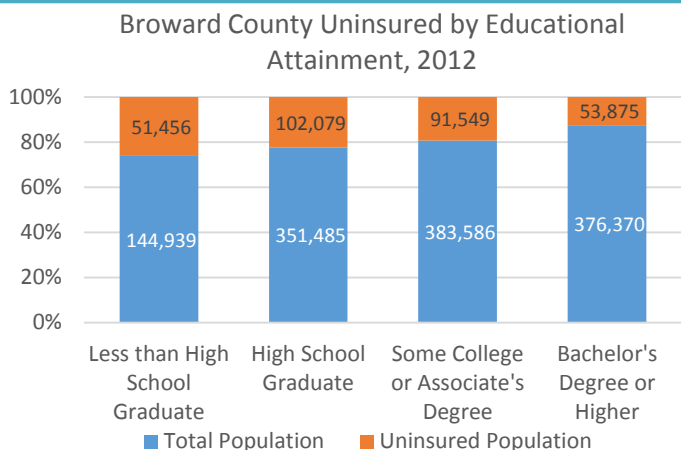
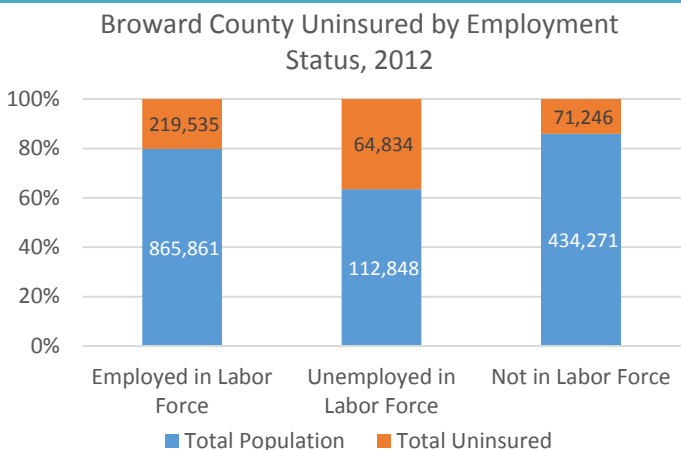

When looking at the uninsured rate by demographics those who are most effected are Blacks (29.2%), residents between the ages of 18 and 64 (30.3%) and males (24.1%). More specifically, in regards to age and gender, those that are most effected by not having insurance are males who are between the ages of 25 and 34.



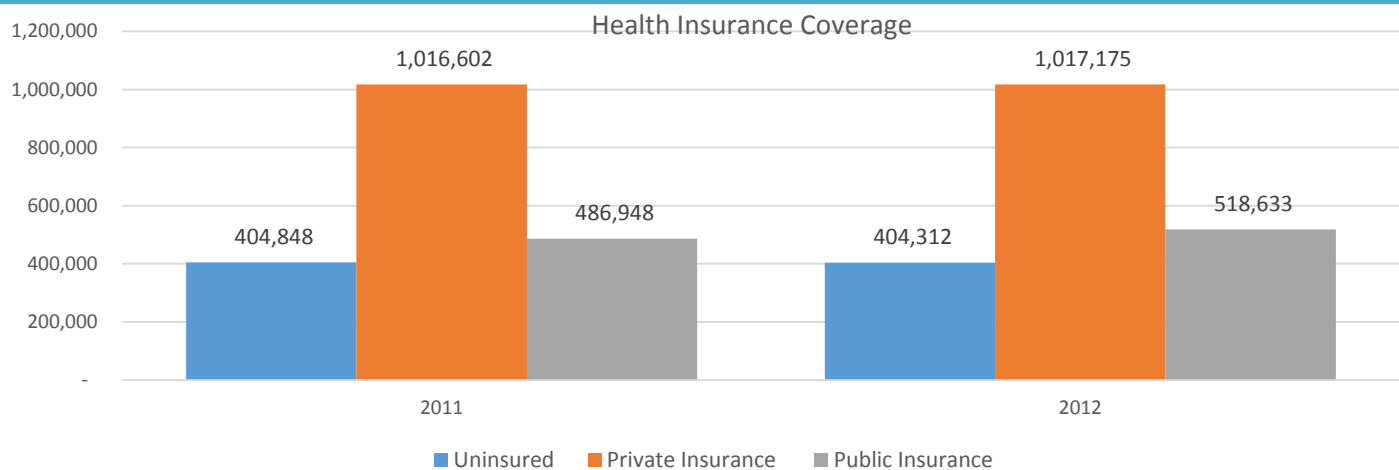

Poverty and educational attainment are factors that contribute to the likelihood of a person having insurance. In 2012, the following groups were more likely to be uninsured: people who did not complete high school, those who are unemployed and those who live at or above 300 percent of the poverty line.

From 2011 to 2012 the number of uninsured decreased slightly (from 404,848 to 404,312). During that same time there were increases in both private and public insurance coverage with a more substantial increase in public insurance (from 486,948 to 518,633).
