I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:06 p.m.

II. Welcome/Introductions

CQM Staff welcomed everyone and individual introductions were made.

III. Evaluating Mental Health Assessment & Treatment Planning

- Workgroup Meeting Summary – Jamie Powers

Jamie Powers presented an overview of the workgroup meeting held on January 14, 2020. There were two main takeaways from this meeting – there needs to be improvements in the Behavioral Health assessment process that are agreed upon by Ryan White-funded behavioral health agencies, and providers need a way to accurately produce measurable outcomes for clients with completed treatment plan goals. To improve the assessment

process, the Network was led into a discussion evaluating the processes in which biopsychosocial assessments are administered to clients in care.

- **Next Steps**

The Network members discussed differences in agency processes and level of care (maintenance care vs intensive treatment) provided to clients. Network members discussed the need for brief assessments and biopsychosocial assessments depending on client situation and level of care provided. Network members suggested that the workgroup develop a brief assessment in PE, that can be used on its own or can serve as the beginning of the biopsychosocial assessment depending on client need. The workgroup will meet to develop the questions for the brief assessment. CQM support staff will contact Network members with details regarding the workgroup meeting.

III. Activity: Pathways to Mental Health

Network members participated in the activity (detailed in handout) to identify the process for receiving mental health care including intake, assessment, treatment planning and follow-up. The posters created from this activity are attached.

IV. Announcements

Broward House announced that they are looking to hire a Master-level Case Manager and Master-level Social Worker (LCSW)

Broward Community and Family Health Centers announced that they are seeking to hire a Behavioral Health Therapist.
